JUNIORS SOPHOMORES FRESHMAN

A cumulation of 120 hours over four years is required for graduation recognition.

- 1. Projects which are sponsored by a Sprayberry club/organization. These hours can be submitted by the individual student with sponsor signature or by the club/organization.
- 2. Projects which are sponsored by Sprayberry High School. These hours can be submitted and verified in a similar manner to #1.
- 3. Projects outside of Sprayberry High School but benefiting the Sprayberry community. This project would have to be confirmed as assisting or benefiting members of the Sprayberry High School attendance zone and verified by an adult supervisor.
